How to perform Backups

Overview

Backups should be performed daily to protect your business from issues such as hardware failure, software corruption, computer virus, fire, adverse weather conditions etc.

Profit-Track™ is normally setup to run **automatic** backups daily which does a backup to your computer.


Independent Solutions also recommends you perform a **manual on demand** backups daily and rotate through 7 USB sticks. At the end of the month an 8th stick should be used. All USB sticks should be kept **off-site** overnight (take them home with you).

- 1. Setup path for On Demand Daily Backups
 - Insert one of the USB sticks into the PC. We are not backing up here – just setting the backup path.
 - Click Setup ➤ System Settings ➤ System
 Options ➤ Backups ➤ OnDemand Backup
 - Click and then My Computer to find the USB drive. This will probably be called Removable Disk. Double click the drive and click [OK] to select.
 - Click Save
 - Click Close

NOTE: this can be changed from the Backup screen if required.





- Click File ➤ Backup ➤ On Demand Backup
- Insert USB stick, CD or plug in external drive.
- The destination menu path will default to the location of your last backup.
- Click Change to change the location for the backup if required.
- Make sure all Databases are ticked.
- Click <u>Start</u>. Please insert disk in [drive] will display. Make sure backup device is inserted and press OK
- Backup Complete message displays when done.
- Click <u>Close</u>



3. Check the backup file was created

- Click Start / My Computer (bottom left of screen).
- Find the USB drive.
- The Backup file should be dated today and look like this:




Remove old files

■ When the USB starts to fill up – delete the oldest backup to make more room (right click on the file and then press *Delete*).

4. How to check AUTOMATIC backups have run overnight.

- The Automatic backup task is normally scheduled to run every night.
- This should be checked daily to ensure the Task has run.
